ARCHITECTURAL MODELLING – Noel Leaver

N GAUGE PROJECTS – Greg Phillips

Greg has provided an up-date on the on-going projects for the N Gauge Group.

Running Track. We are currently finalising the design and construction of two extra boards. The two outer lines are Kato track and incorporate Kato uncoupling sections which will allow us to practice uncoupling using Kato, American?, and Dapol magnetic couplings. Tracks 3 and 4 will each incorporate a removable section, one on one board and one on the other, and probably a selection of permanent and electromagnets to allow practice with other types of magnetically operated couplings. The removable sections will allow experimentation with a range of electronic devices. For normal use, there will be plain track sections. Track 3 will also eventually be sectioned around its entirety to allow experimentation with automatic train control. The running track will be useable in either 4 board as now, or 6 board form.

Tamar Bridge. Before the site visit in April, we need to establish a set of objectives to be investigated. The most important of these is the balance between an attractive layout to build, view and operate, with our ability to store it in the cellar and maintain it at a show. To identify potential problems and allow development of potential solutions, I have produced relevant OS maps in 3 different sizes covering track from the end of St Budeaux goods yard to Defiance platform, Henn point, on the Cornish side.

Wickwar. Two developments here:

Firstly, the vehicles are regularly causing problems. The lorries have done a lot of miles and we really need more. Noel is experimenting with a new motor and gearbox that is less vulnerable to fluff and has established that a range of batteries can be used. Unfortunately, the magnets fitted to the latching relays may be becoming demagnetized and the steering mechanism is delicate and may be suffering from excessive wear. The coaches have steering problems that may be curable, but their numbers and some types are not prototypical unlike the trains.

Secondly, members would like to run later era stock particularly if Noel's or mine are not available. We agreed when building the layout this would be acceptable. However, stock running on Wickwar **MUST** be prototypical, locos of an acceptable type with head codes and crews, passenger stock of the correct type and formation - we have very good information on this, goods trains similarly. I also would prefer nothing after 1960 as the stocks physical condition became appalling. DC locos with older, non can, motors **MUST** have a larger suppression capacitor fitted, see me for this.

David has been surfing the net for items of interest and happened upon the attached site that offers magnetic coupling links to replace the OO NEM couplings:


